Subject: Tribal State Tax Exempt Letter

To Whom It May Concern,

This letter will serve as a Nevada State Sales Tax Exemption for purchases by Tribal Employees on behalf of the Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe's (Tribe, Tribe's, Tribal) Reservation and Colony (Tribal Trust Land) and having products or materials delivered within its' boundaries. The State of Nevada recognizes that any purchases sold and delivered to Tribal Trust Land are exempt from Nevada sales tax pursuant to the State of Nevada NRS 372.800, 372.805, and 372.810.

Tribal Trust land is under the tax jurisdiction of the Tribe's Constitution in Article VI section (g) and under the new Title 11 – Licensing and Taxation Ordinance, adopted 10/23/13. Your business may use this letter to document this State tax exempt transaction. For our Tribal Government, we have various departments that need supplies and materials and the products or materials delivered to the Tribal Trust Land are exempt from the State of Nevada and subject to the Tribe's tax rate.

At this time, the current Tribal Lands under Tribal Trust Land status where deliveries can be made include: the Reservation, the Colony, Fox Peak Fallon (615 W. Williams Ave., Fallon NV 89406), and Fox Peak Fernley (1200 Nevada Pacific Parkway, Fernley, NV 89408). The Tribal Administrative offices are also on Tribal Trust Land and are located at 565 Rio Vista Drive, Fallon, NV 89406. Please remember, the invoice needs to state "Delivered to Tribal Trust Land" or something similar to be exempt from the State of Nevada sales tax. Delivery issues (including the timing of the delivery) are between the Tribal Employee and your Business and the end result is that the transaction will be State sales tax exempt for products or materials delivered to Tribal Trust Land.
