Mayor Tedford Declares Indigenous Peoples' Day

The Mayor joins six states and 130 cities across the United States in renaming the holiday

Goodbye Columbus...

Fallon, NV- Fallon Mayor Ken Tedford joined with tribal representatives at Fallon City Hall to proclaim the day to be Indigenous Peoples Day.

The City of Fallon recognizes Indigenous Peoples Day, as Mayor Tedford invited tribal leaders to city hall Monday, October 14, "Indigenous People's Day, a date recognized by the federal government as "Columbus Day".

Several other places across the United States have also made the switch in a growing movement to end the celebration of the Italian explorer in favor of honoring Indigenous communities and their resiliency.

Indigenous Peoples' Day is a holiday that celebrates and honors the Native Americans and commemorates their shared history and culture. It began as a counter-celebration held on the same day as the U.S. federal holiday of Columbus Day, which honors Italian explorer Christopher Columbus.

The movement to change the second Monday in October from Columbus Day to Indigenous Peoples Day was proposed to the United Nation in 1977, and in 2011, the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians (representing 59 tribal nations) passed Resolution No. 11-57 "Support to Change Columbus Day to Indigenous People's Day."

Chairman George stated he wants people to know the true history of Native Americans and that Indigenous Peoples were and always will be the first people of our nation. In addition he stated Indigenous Peoples Day is about acknowledging our complex history while celebrating the culture, heritage, and strength of native communities. Our ancestors have stewarded this land for generations, as we were the first inhabitants of the land.

Members of the Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe should be encouraged that today the city of Fallon took a significant step towards a better relationship, not just with the Tribe, but with history.

Association (NAFOA)

Neel Kashkari, President, Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis

There are twelve Federal Reserve banks. The Fed has a dual mandate to maximize employment and seek a stabilized economy. The US and global economies are slowing. A primary problem is that industries cannot find workers but Indian reservations have a large untapped supply of workers. The Minneapolis Fed has an Indian Country Center which conducts research on economic development on reservations. Not all Feds conduct this research.

Stephen Lewis, Governor, Gila River Indian Community; Mark Cruz, DAS-PED, Dept of Interior; Donald Pongrace, Consultant

Gila River built a tribal high school using an innovative and first time financing combining 105L Leases and New Market Tax Credits. The project was a collaboration of Gila River, BIA and private financing. The benefit of this project is that other Tribes can use the same mechanism.

Lance Morgan, CEO, Ho-Chunk Tribe; Larry Wright, Chairman, Ponca Tribe of Nebraska; Patrice Kunes, Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis

Tribes are planning to what is called, "7th Generation". If Tribes are to survive they need to be planning out to the 7th generation. Not only are tribes seeking economic development but creating mentoring programs for their future leaders. Tribes are not waiting for schools and families to educate their children but establishing programs for training their children. Tribes are using farming to teach children a work ethic and by growing traditional foods to teach where we came from. They are not just seeking wealth but to channel individual opportunity, "collective wealth with individual opportunity".

Branding Through Storytelling: The Value of Telling Your Tribe's Story

Who we are 2. What we are doing as an organization 3. Why we are doing what it is. People like storytelling. Gabby Williams from Owyhee is the first Indian golfer admitted to the Ladies Professional Golf Association. Honda's philosophy, "Create acts of joy for your customers every day." There is a difference between Branding and Advertisement. During employee orientation, make a heavy dose of culture, one day orientation, go to museum, who am I working for.

Defining Opportunities for Opportunity Zones

Senator Corey Booker sponsored the Opportunity Zone Act. Opportunity zones is a community based capital concept which employs Low Income Tax Credits, New Market Tax Credit and Tribal Economic Development Bonds (Ted Bonds). Opportunity Zones are based on census tracts and are locked until the next census. Opportunity Zones can be found on the IRS or Treasury websites. Also, NAFOA website lists the Opp Zone map. The project drives the financing. Opp Zones offer the investor tax deferral, tax reduction and tax exclusion. Ted Bonds have been reduced to \$75 million in 2019.

Aaron Klein, Economic Advisor, NAFOA; Mark Wright, Research Director, Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis

The USA is currently experiencing the longest economic recovery in history but it is also the slowest. The US investments are experiencing an "inverted yield curve". The unemployment rate is 3.5% but twice as high for African-Americans and Indians. Salaries are not growing. Yet consumer spending is at a strong 70%. Millennials are not buying houses and the housing market still has not recovered from 2008.

Kevin Allis, CEO, National Congress of American Indians

NCAI's goals are inclusion and participation. The immediate needs are criminal justice, infrastructure (weather disasters) and educating people on who NCAI is. It is instituting a resolution process as in a

tribal resolution where tribes can access this service on line. When tribes go to D.C. NCAI wants to meet with you and assist and go with you to The Hill.

Is Your Tribe Set Up to Make Good Investment Decisions?

Potawatomi's philosophy is you must have buy in from the Tribe not the Council. Potawatomi undertook an economic development study based on the 7th generation concept. Tribe's need to be introspective on what it wants to accomplish: do changes matter at all, today; why; what is hold us in place; get organized for long term structure; emulate education where institutions look at long term endowments; hire others firms; do quarterly updates; factor technology; communicate communicate communicate. Engage in backwards planning, i.e. develop how the project will be monitored before establishing the project. Use advisers but ultimately it is the decision of the Tribe and don't be afraid to walk away.

NAFOA Treasury Tribal Advisory Committee (TTAC)

NAFOA created TTAC as a resource for taxation in Indian Country. There is dual taxation of Indian enterprises, New Market Tax Credits, and the General Welfare Exclusion Act. The IRS is treating tribal revenue as gross income which is an income tax. Tribes are arguing this revenue is not income but is used for social and governmental costs such as health, education and housing. The terms "lavish and extravagant" have not been defined by IRS or Treasury. Because state and county governments generate their revenue by taxation, IRS believes revenue from casinos is profit and not governmental revenue.

Tribally Chartered Corporations

In the 1990's Congress passed the Section 17 charter and Section 3 Oklahoma Act which allowed Tribes to create for profit corporations. Because this process can take up to a year to complete many Tribes opted not to create these corporations. Now with new business opportunities Tribes want to have tribally chartered corporations recognized by banks, IRS, Treasury and BIA. There are many obstacles to this.



STEM students see the light

Churchill County Middle School students who showed their entrepreneurial spirit now see the light. Because of their proposal to exchange incandescent lighting with LEDs, they will save the school district thousands and thousands of dollars over time.

Vanessa Roberson, executive director of Envirolution in Reno, which was founded by four Yale students in 2007, has developed Project ReCharge into its flagship program in Nevada in 2015 to recognize students for their projects that make the environment friendlier and to provide instructional material to classrooms. She said Tesla is one of the program's partners as is the Nevada Department of Education's gift fund and several other foundations.

An initial disbursement of \$262,700 to Envirolution was granted this year by Tesla for Project ReCharge, and Robertson said the program will help Nevada's STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) classes and sustainability efforts at the K-12 level.

Robertson said four Fallon eighth-grade students who submitted their proposal last year as seventh graders was one of 10 groups in Nevada to receive recognition and funding. "They did some analysis and energy data collection, and did a great job with it," Robertson said. "They came up with an energy proposal to reduce that energy use."

The students in Randie Orong's class proposed to switch out the 23-watt florescent lights in the sixth-grade building and replace them with 14-watt LEDs. Robertson said each LED light will last 25 times longer than a regular light. Principal Amy Word said she's excited

for the students to receive acceptance of the proposal and to celebrate their success.

"It's nice to be recognized and see this proposal actually happen," she said.

In explaining the project to guests and the team from Envirolution, student William Wallace said his group, which included Payton Smith, Teon

Erwin and Skai Shults, must have counted the light bulbs 10 times to obtain an accurate number.

"We'll be saving about \$1,600 a year," he said, "and over time it adds up. It (savings) can go to water bottle stations."

Orong said the students did their homework in their analysis and "did their math."

"They did a lot of checking and re-checking their facts and a lot of investigation and research on the internet," she said.

Robertson also said the students had excellent data in making their proposal. Word added the school will see a reduction in its power bill because of the new light bulbs.

"Envirolution is providing thousands and thousands of dollars of lights to our school," she said.

"Overtime when we save money on energy, we can put that money into other things. This will benefit a sustainable energy source that's less taxing on our environment."

Another group of last year's seventh-graders who proposed the importance of solar power, did not have their project accepted, but Robertson commended the stu-

dents.

"We like how much you saved the school," she said.

Edmond Brody Allyn, Kasey Lattin and April McCutcheon were in the second group.

Robertson, who was accompanied by Laura Scarselli, project manager; Delanie Bruce, Americorps; and Chaja Hogeweg, marketing and design, said Project ReCharge empowers middle- and high-school students to become energy detectives in finding ways to save their schools money from energy efficiency proposals.

Since 2015, Robertson said the project can be found in 40 schools across nine Northern Nevada school districts, and she added the program will eventually expand to the southern part of the Silver State. Not only has Project ReCharge partnered with 117 secondary teachers by offering more than 6,000 hours of training but it also given teachers access to 16 hands-on STEM lessons and activities for about 23,000 students.

Envirolution has received the Golden Pinecone Sustainability Award for Best Education Program.






Volunteer Swim Instructor



Reviews and researches contract/grant agreements.

Works with the Treasurer and Finance Department to implement approved budgets.

Participates at tribal events and functions. Meets and greets all dignitaries who are visiting or attending functions.

Attends all regular Fallon Business Council meetings, attends other special, closed, executive sessions/meetings.

The Project Manager's primary role is to plan and coordinate the Fallon Tribal Health Center's Circles of Care grant project. 
