

Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe COVID-19/Coronavirus Update

Dear Membership,

The Fallon Business Council wants to continue to update the membership on the most current information as we continue to closely monitor the situation and take action based on the best information available. Currently Churchill County and our Reservation/Colony has no positive tests for COVID-19/Coronavirus. We want to remind you to continue social distancing, shelter-in-place practices, and to wash your hands and sanitize your common areas in your homes. We want to make sure Churchill County stays Coronavirus free.

- The Fallon Business Council has opened it Emergency Operation Center and is in constant contact with our Federal, State, and County/City partners. The Tribe will continue to work with the County and State regarding issues of importance during this time.
- Governor Sisolak has issued a *travel advisory* for the State of Nevada. All people leaving and coming back to the State should self-quarantine for 14 days. This is for the safety of Nevada, in an effort to stop the spread of the COVID-19/Coronavirus.
- Churchill County School District- Extended School Closure NOW THROUGH APRIL 30th: **CRITICAL NOTE: All students ABSOLUTELY need to continue to do the work that is coming out from teachers, PreK through 12th-grade.**
- DMV 90-Day Extension- The State of Nevada has granted an automatic 90-day extension on any driver's license, vehicle registration or other document that has an expiration date of March 16 through April 30, 2020. Download and print the Extension Letter to present to law enforcement on demand.

- We are continuing to operate with essential staff only. Please contact each department before going to their offices.
 - The Health Center is still operating from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Clinic Staff will be triaging you from the parking lot before you are to see a Physician. Please be patient with the staff as we are looking out for everyone's health and safety. We want to provide the best possible care to our membership and community members.
 - Law Enforcement will continue to operate as usual and will continue to patrol the Colony and Reservation. Please continue to be safe.
 - The Fallon Business Council wants our membership to know with the financial stress of these times, we are currently in, Housing renters, lease owners, home owner's and loan payments for April through June 2020 will be waived. We will continue to review this issue, and work in the best interest of our Housing participants. No evictions will happen during this time.
 - We are currently in the process of assessing what our elders' needs are at this time. If you are an elder in need of food, please contact New Frontiers Food Pantry at 775.423-1412, please contact them and we can deliver it to you (there is no minimum income requirement).

Please continue to be safe and look out for your family and friends, especially our elders. We are here to assist you in any way possible. The sacrifices we make NOW are crucial in limiting the spread of this highly contagious illness. We will hold strong and get through this.
