POSITION DESCRIPTION

The TERO Day Laborer will perform work for the completion of the assigned COVID projects, which consists of heavy lifting, moving furniture, some carpentry and painting skills and perform other duties as necessary. Will be called when needed.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Will perform carpentry duties, where necessary.
2. Duties may include lifting, moving furniture.
3. Will perform duties in such a manner that the projects assigned to be completed promptly, safely and efficiently.
4. Will work with designated persons, to develop and complete projects.
5. Other job related duties as assigned by designated supervisor.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be able to lift fifty (50) pounds.
2. Must be able to stand for long periods, bend and lift heavy objects.
3. Some experience in carpentry preferred, but not required.
4. Experience using hand tools preferred, but not required.
5. Required to temperature check every morning before reporting to work at designated areas.
6. Required to wear a mask where required.
7. Must be willing to take and pass a drug screen.
