ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

THE ONLY TRIBAL MEMBERS ELIGIBLE FOR THIS 2nd ROUND OF WOOD DELIVERY ARE THOSE THAT DID NOT RECEIVE WOOD UNDER THE CARES ACT PROGRAM DURING DISTRIBUTION IN DECEMBER OR JANUARY OF 2021

- *Must attach a copy of FPST membership card/document with application.*
- *Delivery is available to FPST members residing on the Fallon Paiute Shoshone Colony, Reservation or Churchill County.*
- *FPST members living outside Churchill County must arrange to pick up wood themselves. (Must pick up within 10 days of notification of approval).*
- *You must **NOT** sell or give away the firewood.*

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act provides financial support to eligible individuals/families who incurred necessary expenses due to the COVID-19 pandemic. By accepting this heating assistance (firewood, pellets, propane, or oil), you certify that you suffered a negative economic impact, and you will use this assistance for your personal use.

Explain where you want your wood delivered at your residence. Example: Dump wood on the north side of my house or dump wood on the south side of my house closer to the canal.
Wood will not be placed next to your house (fire safety).
